

## **SIGNIFICANT ADDITIONAL PUBLIC HOSPITAL AND HEALTH FUNDING PROVIDED BY THE COMMONWEALTH GOVERNMENT SINCE 2007**

- A 50 per cent increase in public hospital funding over the period 2008-09 to 2012-13 including:
  - \$500 million ongoing increase in 2008-09; and
  - An additional \$22.4 billion over five years from 2009-10 through the National Healthcare Specific Purpose Payment.
- An additional \$1.3 billion through the National Partnership Agreement on Hospital and Health workforce Reform;
- A further \$300 million through the National Partnership Agreement on the Elective Surgery Waiting List Reduction Plan; and
- An additional \$643 million through the National Partnership Agreement on Preventative Health.
- Increased capital investment of \$5.0 billion through the Health and Hospitals Fund.
- The Commonwealth government is now offering an additional \$20 billion over this decade through the National Health Reform Agreement comprising:
  - Up to \$3.4 billion through the National Partnership Agreement on Improving Public Hospital Services; and
  - \$16.4 billion guaranteed for efficient growth in hospital activity over the period 2014-15 to 2019-20.
